


IMAGINE YOUR HERITAGE GETTING LOOTED!

Displayed at the British Museum 1926 - 1938

The British Egyptologist, Flinders Petrie, had started his excavations in Gaza, extracting a variety of ancient and priceless artifacts, and relocating them to the British Museum, such as the findings in Tell Al-Ajjul.

Displayed at the Israeli Museum 1951 - 1981

The former Israeli Defense Minister, Moshe Dayan, had looted more than 800 pieces in his excavations in Palestine and Egypt, possessing them as his personal collections, such as Deir Al-Balah's Sarcophagi.

Displayed at the Israeli Knesset 1923 - 2004

The occupying army raided the National Museum, which is linked to the Al-Isra University building, before entirely demolishing it. The museum had around 3,000 rare archaeological objects.



WHILE THE REMAINING ANTIQUITIES IN GAZA GET

During the 2023 - 2024 war, the Israeli occupation systematically destroyed what little remained of archaeological artifacts in the Gaza Strip. This deliberate act aimed to erase both the historical and present identity of Gaza, leaving no tangible heritage for its people to reclaim in the future.
